International Charity Festival of Music and Arts "Zbor de copil"/"Child Flight"

Motto: Together for a different way of being

"Zbor de copil" International Charity Music and Arts Festival is part of the Fundraising Campaign for Victims of Domestic Violence, a campaign initiated by ADRA Romania. Apart the joy of singing and artistic activities, it is the blessing we want the children and young people participating in the Festival to feel, to be useful and to support children and mothers in situations of abuse. This is the message we want to convey through this initiative.

Registration period: May 21 - June 2, 2021 (20.00, Romanian time)

Evaluation: June 3 - June 10 (this date may be subject to change, depending on the number of registered participants; all changes will be submitted on the FB page "Casa ADRA").

Awarding of prizes: June 11 (insofar as previous data were not postponed); there is also the possibility that the results are offered progressively by the jury commissions (the exact time can be found on the Facebook page "Casa ADRA"). The scores obtained will be published on the Facebook page "Casa ADRA" and on Instagram; they will also be found on the pages www.zbordecopil.ro, www.adra.ro.

General criteria:

- The festival is addressed to children and young people, aged between 4 and 18/19 years and to families who register in the session specific to them, section 7, provided they have at least one family member present at the activity who is in the age range 4-18 / 19 years;
- Registration is made exclusively ONLINE;
- For participants from Romania, the diplomas, medals, trophies will be sent through the coordinating teachers (in a single package) or individually. Regarding the participants from outside Romania (Europe), the aspects related to the possibility of transmitting medals and trophies, will be discussed with the coordinating teachers. For other continents, the way of rewarding the participants, together with the teachers, partners of the campaign, will be established.

Although we want that all participants be rewarded in the same way, regardless of the country of registration, we still recognize the geographical limits and therefore we will discuss with the coordinating teachers the best cost/benefit option. However, it is important to remind parents of the charitable nature of this festival as a primary goal.







Age groups:

- 4 6 years
- 7 9 years
- 10 12 years
- 13 15 years
- 16 18/19 years

Festival registration:

Festival participants must complete the following steps:

- 1. Reading the Regulations;
- 2. The use of the Campaign frame (Facebook) by the participant or his/her parent during the Festival;
- 3. Like / Follow They follow on the Facebook page "Casa ADRA" to be up to date with all the information related to the festival.
- 4. Using the hashtags of the #zbordecopil and #mesageradra campaign.
- 5. Filling in the online registration form and uploading the documents necessary for participation: the signed registration form, proof of payment of the participation fee, the link to posting the video on Youtube, photos, musical score, etc. (the link to the registration document will be posted on the Facebook page "Casa ADRA").

Copyright:

Participants declare and guarantee that they have full rights to use all materials sent to evaluation.

By registering for the festival, the participant allows the Organizer (ADRA Romania) to publish the video / photos received, together with the last name and fist name of the participant on the association's website or on any of its Facebook and Instagram pages. Without time or geographical restrictions, ADRA may publish, copy, distribute and use the materials (with the INDICATION OF THE AUTHOR'S NAME) in order to present the activities of the association.

Registration donation

Those who want to get actively involved by participating in the festival, but also in the society in which they live, by supporting children and mothers in situations of abuse, can do so by means of a:

90 LEI donation- registration for a single section (90 LEI = 19 EUR / 27 CAD / 23 USD) 140 LEI donation - registration for 2 sections (140 LEI = 29 EUR / 42 CAD / 35 USD) 180 LEI donation - registration for 3 sections (180 LEI = 37 EUR / 54 CAD / 45 USD) 30 LEI /donation per person (if it is a group / ensemble) - 30 LEI = 6 EUR / 9 CAD / 8 USD. For schools that organize workshops of handmade products, the minimum donation is of 60 lei (instead of 90 lei / section; 110 lei / 2 sections; 150 lei / 3 sections; 15 lei / group member, overall.

- 10% discount for 2 participants from the same family; 15% discount for 3 participants from the same family.

WARNING:1. In case of the donation, the festival + section + name of the competitor shall be mentioned. In case of withdrawal, the fee is not refundable.

2. If the participant pays in a currency other than those in which ADRA Romania has an open bank account (LEI, USD, EUR), he/she will choose the LEI account and the conversion will be performed (e.g. payment of the fee from a pound account will be made in the lei account).

SECTIONS:

- 1. Instrumental music (amateurs and specialized schools / high schools):
 - Piano (acoustic piano, digital piano)
 - Strings
 - Wind instruments

For all subcategories of the section: *The sent video should be recorded in landscape format, with the appropriate brightness.*

The participant will register with a single work of his/her choice.

- 2. Vocal music (amateurs and specialized schools / high schools; solo / ensemble):
 - Cult music (secular, religious)
 - Traditional music (Romanian, universal)

Remarks:

The sent video must be recorded in landscape format, with the appropriate brightness.

The participant will register with a single work of his/her choice.

Traditional music: children's folklore, the song itself, traditional songs, etc.

- 3. Theatre / acting (amateur, professional / individual, group):
 - Scene etc.
 - Poetry recitation
 - Monologue
 - Play

The sent video must be recorded in landscape format, with the appropriate brightness.

Evaluation criteria:

- Originality of the chosen material
- Clarity of speech
- Artistic impression (costume, scenography, choreography, etc.)







- The emotional impact

4. Literary creations:

- Short prose
- Poetry

The works will be typed in Romanian, font 12, Times New Roman, maximum 1000 words. The material entered must be spelled correctly and grammatically correct.

Evaluation criteria:

- The text has to be correctly structured, to have an attractive introduction, a coherent content and a memorable conclusion
- The angle of approach has to be as original as possible, the narrative voice as authentic as possible
- The use of style figures is dosed in a balanced way, the constructed images being well harmonized with each other and contributing to the strength of the text, without burdening it.
- The text has to be divided into scenes that have life: it presents experiences, emotions, thoughts in a way that appeals to the most relevant senses.

5. Visual arts:

- Painting (on different surfaces), Drawing
- Drawing

For painting and drawing: The works should be sent in portrait or landscape format, depending on the orientation of the work.

3 photos of the creations will be sent.

Evaluation criteria:

- Balanced in terms of colour and composition;
- Original
- Graphics
- Photography (landscape, portrait, street, fine art / still life, various)

3 photos from the selected subsection will be sent.

It is recommended that photos be taken with a camera, but it is also acceptable to use the phone, but with a resolution greater than 2000 px on the long side.

• Video

The sent video must be recorded in landscape format, with the appropriate brightness.

Clip duration: between 30 sec. and 5 minutes.

Appearance: 16: 9, minimum resolution 1920x1080p, mp4 format or similar.

6. Handmade creations (collage, quilling etc.)

The works should be sent in portrait or landscape format depending on the orientation of the work. The works can be made with / on any type of material.

A maximum of 3 photos will be sent for each work participating in the festival (one in which the participant will be together with the work, and the other 2 only with the work, from angles that will provide an overview of what is on display).







7. My family (family moment):

- Music (vocal, instrumental, vocal-instrumental)
- Theatre
- Painting
- Cooking
- Reading
- Any family activity worth sharing.

The sent video must be recorded in landscape format, with the appropriate brightness. Video length: between 2 and 10 minutes.

JURY

The jury will be international, composed of prominent personalities in the evaluated field (Romania, United States, United Kingdom, Belgium, Italy, Spain, Germany). The scoring of the participants will be done in a judging team, at all sections of the festival. *The jury's decision cannot be contested.*
